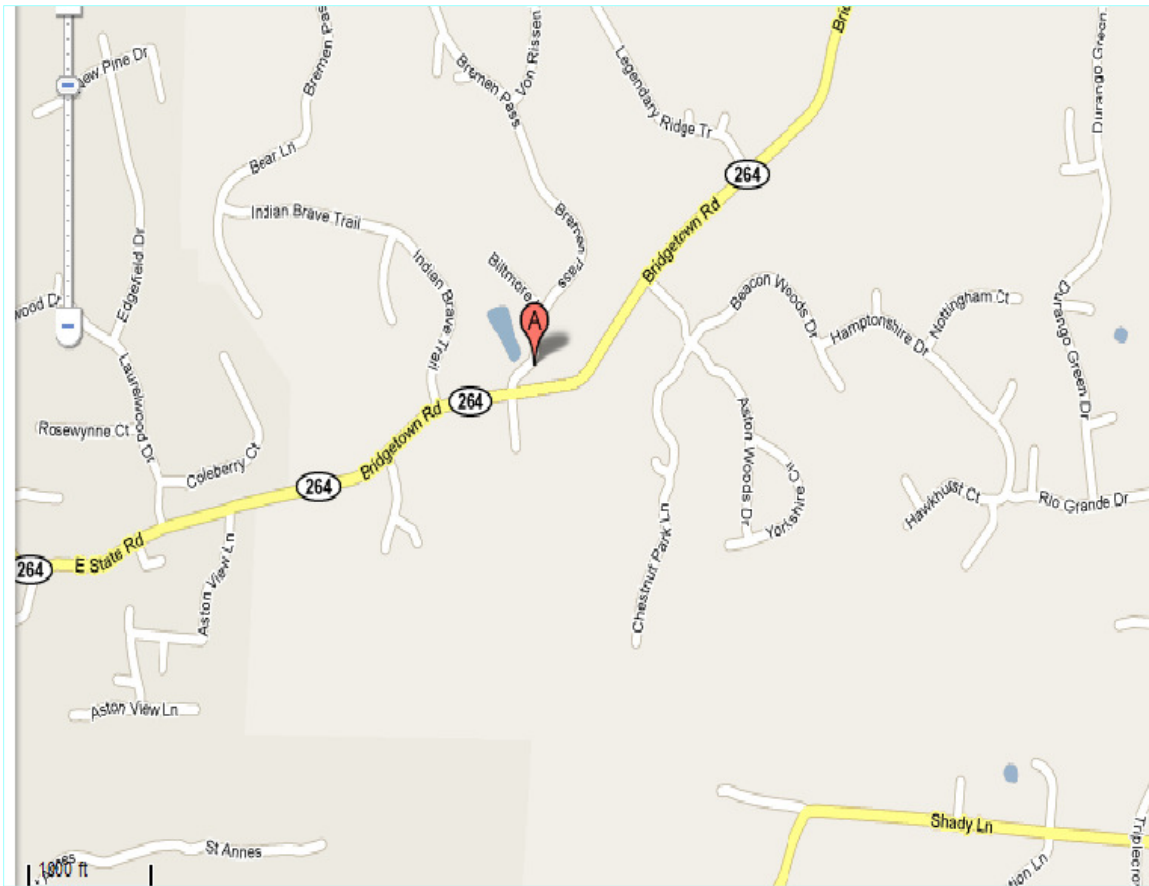

Follow Taylor Road to the first **RIGHT** onto **DOG TROT Road**. Go up Dog Trot until it dead ends into **BRIDGETOWN Road**. Turn **RIGHT** onto Bridgetown Road. Follow Bridgetown Road 2-3 miles until you TURN **RIGHT** onto **BREMEN PASS** in the **VON RISSEN ESTATES** Subdivision. We are the first red brick house on the right.
