>>>Skip Jackson proposed a new concise, more readable format in the newsletter to highlight and list all local car events.



Get on the Norwood Lateral = Route 562 and go westbound.


Take the Paddock Road exit off Route 562.

Turn right at the end of the ramp and go ½ mile north to Towne Street.

Turn left and DVN is ½ mile down on the left immediately after you cross the railroad tracks.

When you leave to go home you can go back across the railroad tracks and take the ramp to I@75 north. If you are heading back to I71 or I74 or I75 south, then stay on Towne Street to Paddock Road. Turn right onto Paddock Road and go ½ mile south to the Norwood Lateral = Route 562. The first ramp to the right is for westbound 562 to I@75 south and then down to I74.

The next ramp past the overpass to the left is for eastbound 562 to 171.
