
To get to Zakira's Garage at 6219 Wooster Pike 45227, which is Route 50. It is next to Wendys Hamburgers in Fairfax. You may use a GPS or take exit # 9 from I-71 for Red Bank Road and merge onto Red Bank Expressway and go 1.4 miles. Becomes Red Bank Road and go 0.9 miles more then merge onto US 50 East via the ramp on the left. The garage is 1.1 miles on the right. Look for a British flag.

From 275 take the Kellogg Avenue west exit # 72 and go west on 52 toward Cincinnati for 4.2 miles. Turn right on Stanley Avenue and go 0.2 mile. This is just after Congress and before Delta. Turn right onto Columbia Pkwy/US-50 E. Continue to follow US-50 E for 4.1 miles. Zakira's at 6219 is on the right just past Simpson Avenue.

You may take exit # 57 for Milford from I-275 and go south / east on Route 28 for 1.4 miles and it becomes US 50 and go 6.8 miles more. Zakira's will then be on the left before Mainliner.

If you want to take Columbia Parkway from downtown or 471, just head east on it where it starts and stay on it for 8.9 miles.

We will wrap up the tour before noon and depart either by freeways or some back roads. This was discussed at the May meeting and approved by Chris Wolfer and Don Butler. 
Pre-registration is \$12.00 before June 20 (see flyer for details), and goes up to \$20.00 after June 20. Use the form to register by mail.
