Time: The main gate opens before 9:00 AM. Registration is the first 20 cars with up to 25 drivers. The maximum is usually reached BE-FORE 10:00 AM. Runs start as soon as possible. Clean up about 3:30. The more help picking up cones and cleaning the earlier we leave.

August 11 members of the Ohio Valley Austin Healey Club Tech Team assisted club member John Wallace to remove and reinstall the crank nut at the correct torque setting on his 1959 Austin Healey.





August 12 members of the Ohio Valley Austin Healey Club Tech Team assisted Club member Nate Fuson to determine the cause of excessive oil consumption OVAHC tech team members Richard, Bernie, Dale, and Tim met on Sunday Aug 12 at Nate Fuson's shop to troubleshoot his massive Sprite oil leak. Not as easy as one thinks. After running the car a while on jack stands, the source of the leak was indeterminate. We decided to drop the pan and look at seals, they were ok, but we added a little silicone for good measure before reassembling. We took a drive in three cars to Subway lunch, then a long 20 mile drive back to Nate's shop. When we returned the oil drip out of the back of the engine was at least

two drops per second. Nate will consult with other club members and see about a new elastomer rear seal assembly to replace the slinger and scroll that is being overpowered by his new high pressure oil pump now. Nate will probably drive the car (it looks and runs great!) to September Roundup while carrying a lot of extra quarts of oil. The likely winter project for the tech team is to pull the engine and install a new rear seal. ion in his recently restored Austin-Healey square body Sprite
