Annual Delegates meeting Sat/Sun Nov 11/12, 2023

In person Indianapolis & Zoom meeting:

28(+/-) of 50+ clubs represented; 8 (+/-) were on Zoom

Roger has proven with actions that the club is to be run/directed my its membership under his leadership. He established an open invitation to any member to discuss any idea or issue at the monthly officers meeting. With prior request of your topic to Edie. Headline:

Dues and Marque distribution (printed and digital) will remain the same for 2024.

We were supposed to get an easily accessible digital version of the printed Membership Directory in 2023 which did not happen. Roger promised that it would happen in 2024 and we allocated \$3000 in the budget to enlist help if needed.

Last year the 2-tiered membership (printed or digital Marque) I presented was not allowed to be vetted by Gary F. Under Roger's NON authoritarian/open leadership, Bill Walton of the Carolinas re-introduced it. Roger promised that it would be ready for next year. A committee of Bill, Ried Trummel, Mike Schnider, Bev Sealand, Steve Bell and me were empowered to have a proposal ready to implement for 2025 re-newel.

The delegate approved that international members (overseas) would be all digital in 2024. Mailing cost are exorbitant.

Conclave:

2023 Crystal River FL. – Had about 100 registrations and financially broke even.

2024 Sep 15 – 19 Elkhart Lake WS. The Wisconsin club is going all out for this conclave. The Friday, Saturday and Sunday prior (Sep 13-15) to Conclave there will be a series of Healey races similar to the 1990 Healey Challenge with cars coming from England and Australia. Conclave registrants will get discounted race tickets and Healey parking in the paddock. The hotel rates for Conclave apply. I am planning on being there to cheer Jeff on. Jeff & Nancy and Jake and Joyce are already registered.

The Gymkhana will be running the go cart track. The car show will be on Main St. of Elhart Lake. There are numerous attractions a few short miles in various directions, Harley Davidson Museum in Milwaukee, The Experimental Aircraft Museum (EAA) in Oshkosh and Lambeau Field in Green Bay.
