TECH TEAM

On Thursday, November 20, three members of the OVAHC Tech Team and a friend / previous co-worker of Jerry's met at the Batavia garage of Jerry Cox. We were at it again to try to get his MGB's engine head installed without any coolant leaks into the #3 cylinder. Three previous attempts failed due to head studs being damaged and not allowing the full and proper clamping force for the head to block seal. This time we had a virgin set of ARP bolts (the best), and we double checked everything before assembling. Scott Brown and John Wallace started the session by using a video probe to inspect each threaded head stud recess into the block and then cleaning and blowing out all the holes. Scott had previously used a flat surfacing stone on the block to ensure a flat, smooth surface and then was cleaned with solvent. Tim Ross installed a new Heli-Coil insert into the rearmost exhaust manifold tapped hole in the head – replacing the previously damaged Heli-Coil. Tim R. then checked all the other manifold stud mounting holes and studs for decent fit and threads, and all were labeled as to which spot to install. Tim Akers, who has a varied car collection, joined us and verified our preparations and plans for the head installation. Scott drove and bought a new can of copper coat gasket spray, and he and John Wallace gave the new head gasket two coats, per previous discussions with Don Klein. Then using two old head studs for alignment, the gasket was dropped onto the head, the head was lowered, the old locating studs removed and all the new studs were installed with a little anti-seize on each tip going fully into the block. Push rods for the valve train were then installed using assembly lube on the pushrod tips and valve stem tops. With the valve train in place, we could then add the hardened flat washers and the special ARP nuts to the studs using the supplied ARP assembly lubricant. A standard head stud tightening sequence was followed to bring the final torque up to 50 ft-lbs in three steps, starting in the center of the head and proceeding front and back to the ends. Similar installation of the exhaust and intake manifolds onto the side of the head proceeded, using new brass nuts except for the rearmost stud which had to be inverted to work with the fine thread Heli-Coil and thus needed a coarse threaded steel nut.

Charleen Cox had ordered a lunch of sandwiches for us and we took a break – while hoping that the new head studs and gasket accomplished their job. After lunch we worked on the exhaust system, which will require some removal of the exhaust pipes to access the flanges and install some new studs from Moss. Tim A. and Scott installed the heater water control valve onto the side of the block and John added antifreeze solution – our first quality check on the head and gasket. Good News!! No green fluid in any of the cylinders. Bad News – green fluid leaking from the heater control valve mount. So, some of the antifreeze was drained back out and the offending valve removed. The new gasket was damaged, so Scott cut a new one out of some rubbery material that Jerry had in his bicycle shop. We then took time to check the tapped length of the valve mounting bolt holes in the block and adjusted the length of the bolts to ensure they clamped the valve without bottoming. Tim A. used infinite patience to get the bolts started and tightened again. Then the antifreeze was refilled and NO MORE LEAKS! Next time we will get the exhaust system back together and reinstall the carbs, set the timing and run the engine for the first time in two years.




