US Dollar Strength-A Great Time to Buy Healey Parts?

It is still a great time to buy British parts. The conversion rate today (1/11/17) is 1.21 compared to 1.57 in November 2014.



## Does Your Healey Leak Around the Bottom of the Windshield Frame?

Does your Healey leak where the windshield frame sits on the shroud? Healey's are especially susceptible to water leaks where the windshield frame and rubber seal fit across the shroud/fender gap on both the driver's side and passenger side. If it does, use a 3M product called Urethane Seam Sealer, part # 08367 with a caulk gun and apply it underneath the rubber seal. For this application use urethane, not silicone. Available from NAPA.
