Jack Porter offered a suggestion to me to improve the lights on my Healey. I installed



Wagner Halogens H6024's. It made a huge improvement to driving at nite. Purchased from Advance Auto.

when replacing your valve cover gasket. Apply on the valve cover side of the gasket. I suggest letting it cure for a few hours after placing the gasket on the valve cover. Use just oil between the gasket and head. It worked great for me after I adjusted my valves.






