Brake Light Switch

This did not work but I share it with you so no one else wastes the time trying it.

Over the years I must have had 3 of these brake light switches fail. So I soaked it overnight in lacquer thiner, sprayed the inside with electrical cleaner, activated the

mechanism a few times with a long drill bit and although I can feel the switch moving, no electrical connection is made. So new switch is on order. If I could feel energetic I would fit a mechanical switch but these days I take the easy route.

Rear Bumper Overriders

When we were part of the North Texas club there was a guy with a big Healey who's rear bumper overriders had the top two inches cut off so that the trunk lid had clearance to open. That may be an extreme out of alignment problem and a radical way to fix it but it is fairly common to see bumpers out of alignment and or overriders leaning one way or another affecting the appearance of the car.

There is a fairly easy way - not for the timid - to get the rear bumper installed and looking good if the brackets are not now straight.

- 1). Remove the bumper and set it aside for now.
- 2) Ensure the structure inside the boot is sound and that the four bumper brackets are moved rearward in the slots before the four bolts are tightened.
- 3. Eyeball the bolt holes in the brackets where the bumper attaches as well as eyeball the curved brackets and see if they are in alignment with each other and perfectly horizontal with the rear body. (Note the eyeball method is is very accurate) use a straight edge or pull a line if you like but the end result will be no better.
- 4. Adjust brackets where necessary by sliding a long metal tube over the end of each bumper bracket to bend it up or down until all four are aligned and horizontal.
- 5. Make sure the face of each bracket is vertical and adjust by twisting with a long adjustable wrench.
- 6. Take a measuring tape and see if left and right bracket pairs are equal distance from rear body.
- 7. Test fit bumper and overriders to ensure trunk lid has adequate clearance and for appearance of bumper end gaps and body line. Make adjustments where necessary.

Note: it helps to have a few taper punches on hand to get the bumper bolts aligned with brackets. Washers might be needed to act as fine adjustment shims between bumper and brackets.


