

Regardless if you are a shooting enthusiast or just curious to learn a little about firearms, their safety and/or mark shooting off your bucket list this is your opportunity.

We will start off with a ½ hour ish session, taught by a female Range Safety Officer (RSO). Goal is to demystify shooting and firearms.

It will encompass a Range Safety Procedures video (3 min) required for all entering the range area, then an introduction to firearms with an emphasis on safety. It will be geared toward anyone who wants to understand the differences between the common types of firearms (revolvers; automatic, bolt, lever action), how to handle and check if they are loaded, and know their key safety features. If you have something specific you want covered, let me know. Regardless of your level of knowledge, you will learn something.

After the session, we will have at least 2 ranges for our private use for as much shooting as we want as well as the cafe &patio for a light dining of (Subway or something similar and soft drinks - No alcohol please) and conversation.

John and I will have a selection of firearms/sizes for you to try.

Hand guns, at least one of each of the following calibers (22 cal; 25 acp; 32 acp; .380 acp; 38 S&W; 9 MM; 45 acp) and a few Long guns (bolt, auto [M1 Garand], lever [Henry]).

You are welcome to bring you own or can rent something you been wanting to try from Premier for \$10 to 15/hr.

There will be knowledgeable people available to answer questions and assist at the firing line in addition to the RSO.

If you want to shoot and eat, the cost will \$20 to \$25 each which covers the cost of food, range time, the introduction, waiver fee, eye and ear protection.

In addition you will be ask to pay the cost of the bullets (10 cents for a 22; 30 cents for a 9MM; 50 cents for the others to over a \$1+ for the 30.06's each) and targets (\$1 each) you use.
